## CIA EXAM REVIEW

---

The Certified Internal Auditor (CIA) is a true mark of the internal auditing professional. In order to attain the designation “Certified Internal Auditor,” a qualified candidate must successfully pass a written examination. The CIA exam is now available year-round. Check the IIA’s website more details on the registration process: [www.theiia.org](http://www.theiia.org).

The examination is divided into four parts (3.5 hours each) and is based on the “Common Body of Knowledge of Internal Auditors.” The parts are the following:

- 1) The Internal Audit Activity’s Role in Governance, Risk, and Control (review Saturday, March 6, 8:00 – 11:30 a.m).  
3.5 CPE credits in Auditing.
- 2) Conducting the Internal Audit Engagement (review Saturday, March 6, 12:30 – 4:00 p.m).  
3.5 CPE credits in Auditing.
- 3) Business Analysis and Information Technology (Based on participant request, **one full day** of review Sunday, March 7, 8:00 – 11: 30 a.m. and 12:30 – 4:00 p.m).  
4 CPE credits in Computer Science and 3 CPE credits in Accounting
- 4) Business Management Skills  
Not reviewed live – see free offer below.

Complimentary access to Roger’s on-line internal audit manual ([www.auditmanual.org](http://www.auditmanual.org)) will be given to all attendees for 60 days to supplement the CIA review materials provided in-class.
