CHAPTER ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM ("CAP") UPDATE

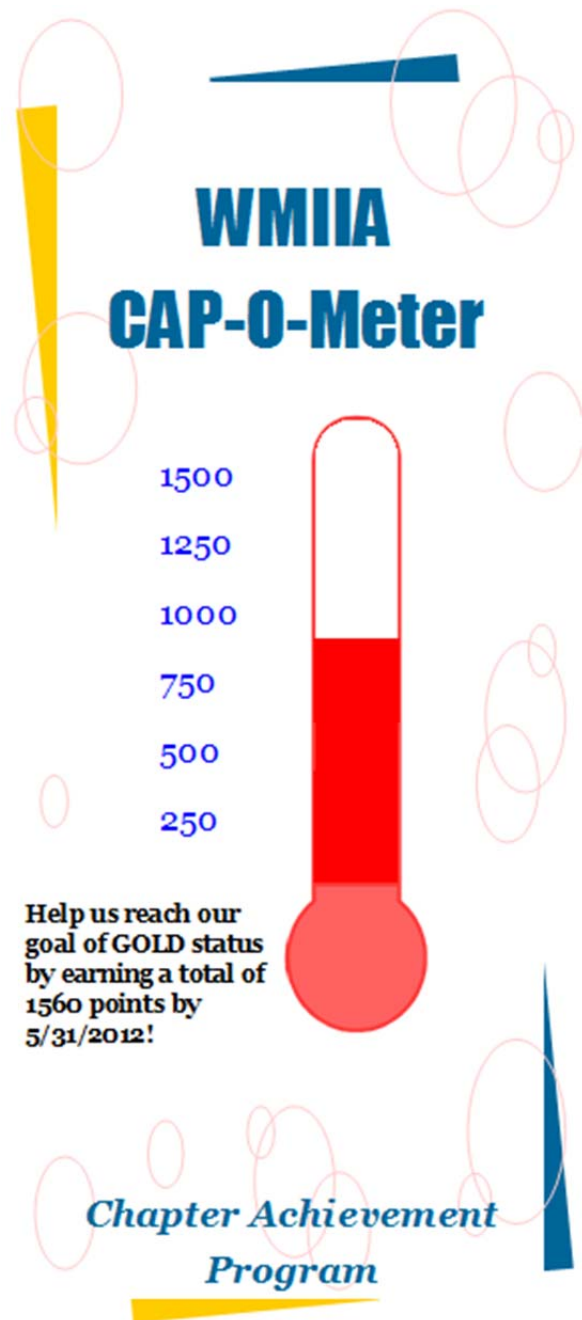
The IIA awards chapters CAP points in three areas (Service to the Profession, Service to Members, and Chapter Administration) to facilitate chapter planning activities and to reward chapters and the members. Our Chapter goal is to again achieve GOLD status by earning a minimum of 1,560 points.

Our current CAP status as of **December 31, 2011** is 886 points. The deadline to earn the 1,560 points needed to maintain our Gold Status is the end of our chapter year which is May 31, 2012.

As a reminder, as members, you can help our Chapter earn points to achieve GOLD status in the areas of Service to the Profession and Service to Members by:

- **Any time you speak about the profession to others outside of your company (without receiving a fee). Simply provide us with the date of the speech, the topic, the audience, and the length of the speech**
- Attending CPE programs offered by our Chapter
- Speaking to a group about audit or IIA-related topics
- Submitting an article to a trade publication such as *Internal Auditor*
- Participate in student-oriented activities such as student internships

Help our Chapter achieve GOLD status for our next chapter year by simply notifying a Chapter Officer or Board Member with details of service activities.
