We are pleased to have Mr. Richard Chambers, the President of IIA, to deliver a presentation on **“The Global Financial Crisis: Are There Lessons for Internal Audit?”**

As the global financial crisis unfolds, internal auditors have discovered that they are not immune from the impact. At the same time, they are identifying new strategies by which they can contribute to the success of their organizations. This presentation will highlight the results of a recent worldwide survey of the internal audit profession on the impacts of the current financial crisis. In addition, it will offer insights on ways the profession is providing greater value in these challenging times. Finally, it will highlight initiatives being taken by The IIA Global Headquarters and Institutes around the world to raise the profile of the profession.

Mr. Richard Chambers

Mr Richard Chambers is the CEO and President of the Institute of Internal Auditors, which is a global organization for the internal audit professionals established in 1941, with over 165,000 members in 165 countries.

Chambers began his career in 1976 with the U.S. General Accounting Office, where he first became an internal auditor. He firmly established himself in government internal auditing and was named Worldwide Director of Internal Review for the United States Army in 1993. He later served as Deputy Inspector General for the United States Postal Service and Inspector General for The Tennessee Valley Authority. In 2001, Chambers joined The IIA staff as vice president, Learning Center. After a brief tenure as "acting president," he left The IIA in 2004 to join PricewaterhouseCoopers, where he most recently served as national practice leader, Internal Audit Advisory Services.

Prior to relocating his family to Singapore in 1998, he held audit management positions at the Stanford University, University of California, and Coopers & Lybrand (now PricewaterhouseCoopers) in San Francisco Bay Area. During the first four of his 28 year span of career, he was a programmer/analyst developing and maintaining systems for Walt Disney Company in Burbank, California. Larry earned an MBA and a degree in Information Systems from the California State Polytechnic University. He is a Certified Public Accountant (California) and Certified Information Systems Auditor.
