Online criminals are motivated to steal your company's and your employees' information. They pretend to be something or someone that they are not in order to get your company secrets and personal data. A growing and concerning trend is use of phishing websites and messages to trick people into disclosing this information by appearing to be from a legitimate and trusted source, such as your company, your bank, and your friends. Although this isn't a new threat or risk, the speed and effectiveness of these criminals ability to circumvent our defenses is accelerating, and our trust in automated, preventative controls is rapidly eroding.

This webinar will speak to the background to this phishing activity including

- profiling of the threats behind the criminal behaviour,
- a demonstration of a few of the latest technical vulnerabilities that are being exploited,
- how and in what manner our controls are failing, and
- discuss the impacts associated with this risk.

In conclusion, this webinar will provide recommendations on how audit teams can include a review of the controls around 'phishing' in audit programs to accurately reflect on your organization's exposure, and to help management respond in effective ways.
