Chapter Member Survey Results

Each year, the chapter issues its Member Satisfaction survey. Using a similar survey as was used in the past, the following summarizes the 2023 Member Satisfaction survey:

- 97 percent of members feel as though the chapter exceeds their expectations to a moderate or great extent,
- 97 percent are pleased with the chapter's programming offerings,
- 67 percent want virtual programming,
- 58 percent want in-person programming,
- over 80 percent want programming on Thursdays or Fridays, and
- no one wants programming on Mondays.

Advocacy Update

One of The IIA's initiative for the next several years is advocacy. The IIA has established a new division to the initiative and those within the division are working with chapter leaders to bring about awareness of the internal audit profession.

On Thursday, July 6, IIA FWC chapter leaders along with our district representative, Meghan Boyd from the Palm Beach County chapter, will join Michael R. Downing, Senior Director of U.S. Advocacy from The IIA to meet with Congressman Gus Bilirakis. The Congressman represents Florida's 12th congressional district which covers Citrus, Hernando, and most of Pasco counties. The Congressman serves as the senior member of the Energy and Commerce committee, chairman of the Innovation, Data and Commerce subcommittee, and senior member of the Health subcommittee and Communications and Technology subcommittee.
