The critical connection between audit committee effectiveness and internal auditing mandates that committee members maintain an in-depth understanding of internal audit best practices and how their internal audit activity is functioning. To assist you and City Commission members in establishing an effective audit committee, I've attached The IIA's "Model Audit Committee Charter," which provides leading practices typically included in an audit committee charter.
