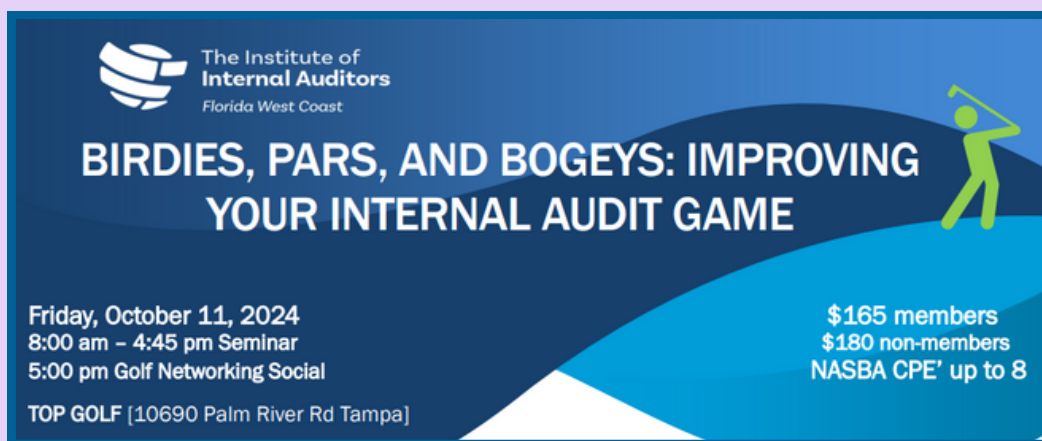

Academic Relations - Recent Visits



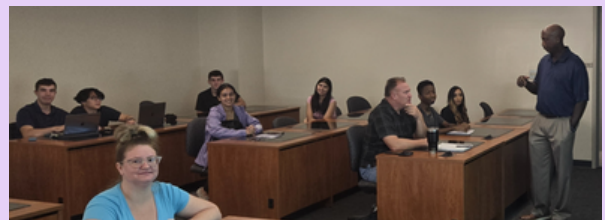

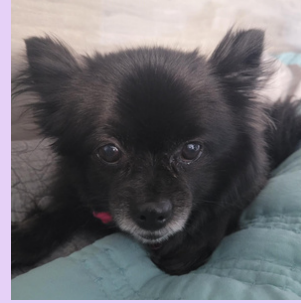
No Exceptions: Furry Friends Check All the Right Boxes

LUCIA



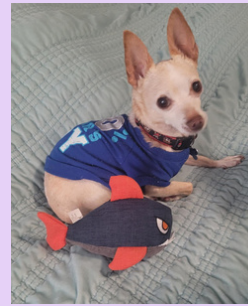
Lucia is a fluffy black Pomeranian and the only girl in the family! She loves everyone – people and animals – and loves jumping in the water!
