Through the generous support of our chapter, the IIA Heartland-Iowa Chapter has established a scholarship fund to provide financial assistance to those interested in pursuing educational opportunities in the field of information systems/ technology (IS/IT), computer sciences, finance, accounting, risk management, or related studies (i.e., hereafter, the "Scholarship"). Scholarship Award

The IIA Heartland-Iowa Chapter is allocating **\$1,000** for the 2023-2024 academic year Scholarship fund. Two (2) \$1000 awards will be available for individual Scholarship. The Scholarship awards will be made payable in the name of the recipient.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

The IIA Heartland-Iowa Chapter has established the following eligibility criteria for the 2023-2024. Scholarship award requirements:

- 1. All candidates must be pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree.
- 2. All awards can be used for part-time and full-time programs.
- 3. The Scholarship award is applicable for one school year term only (2023-2024). However, recipients may re-apply in subsequent years.
- 4. Students must be enrolled for the 2023-2024 academic year, focusing on information systems (IS), IT/Computer sciences, accounting, finance, risk management or related studies.
- 5. Students must be enrolled in an accredited university in the Eastern Iowa and Western Illinois regions.
- 6. Minimum 3.25 (out of 4.0) Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).
- 7. Completion of the scholarship application form, including supporting information.
- 8. Scholarship awards will be granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or national origin.
- 9. International students are welcome to apply.
- 10. Recipient is invited and encouraged to attend, during the award period: 2 chapter events (free of charge) / 1 virtual IIA Heartland-Chapter board meeting to receive the reward.

Scholarship Procedures and Selection Criteria

The Scholarship application form and supporting documentation must be submitted electronically to the IIA Heartland Chapter Scholarship Committee (email address > The IIA Heartland-Iowa < Chapter 260@theiia.org > no later than 11:59 pm US Central on December 15, 2023. Late submissions will not be accepted. All decisions made by the Scholarship Committee shall be considered final. Final award decisions will be made no later than January 30, 2024. The Scholarship Committee will review and evaluate all applications and supporting documentation and will award the Scholarships based on:

- ✓ Individuals that exhibit a sincere desire for further education or training in the related fields expressed above;
- ✓ Individual achievement as evidenced through participation in outside interests and activities, leadership roles and/or work experience;
- ✓ Grade point average and/or academic credentials; and,
- ✓ Other criteria as deemed appropriate by the Scholarship Committee.
