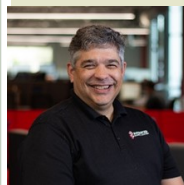
PRESENTATION SUMMARY

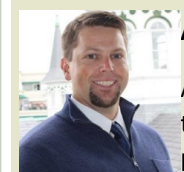

Organizations aren't focused on cyber risk amid pandemic. Here is an excerpt from the article:

"Over the last year, organizations have had to transform at an accelerated speed that would have been thought impossible just a short time ago. However, many organizations did not involve risk management functions or cybersecurity in the decision-making process, not necessarily due to oversight but rather the urgency of the need to adapt for survival. As a result, these organizations need to address the risks and potential vulnerabilities that were introduced during their transformation efforts at the height of the pandemic while also ensuring cybersecurity resilience for the next major event."
