The Triple Squeeze

Pressure from high inflation, scarce and expensive talent, and global supply constraints.

Re-Nationalization

Uprooting assumptions of reliance on a global, just-in-time market. Shifting towards different regional and local business.

Rethinking Resilience

As the pace of uprooting events increases, organizations need to evaluate their fragility and implement resilience measures for long-term thinking.
