IIA Detroit Chapter 2022-2023 Year-in-Review

It has been a great chapter year! The Detroit IIA continued to show its commitment, strength and resilience in providing leadership, valuable programming and professional recognition for our members in the Metro-Detroit area of Southeast Michigan. Here are some key highlights:

- Continued to serve in our 80th chapter year
- Maintained ~900 members, representing over 100 companies/organizations, Detroit continues to be one of the largest IIA chapters in the United States
- Held 8 monthly meetings, 1 Conference, 4 webinars and attendance totaled 1,280 for all events.
- Achieved "Sapphire" chapter achievement status (25 consecutive years of gold status chapter health) continued to offer programming, promote and encourage IIA certifications, advocate for the IIA and the profession, and maintained a strong chapter membership.
