As a CISA™ or CPA holder, you can take advantage of this opportunity to earn the Certified Internal Auditor® (CIA®) designation through an expedited process called the CIA Challenge Exam. This expedited process allows you to obtain the CIA designation after successfully passing the one-part examination.

There have been updates to the CIA Challenge Exam program. Below is a list of some of the key changes to the CIA Challenge Exam Program.

1. Updated, Unified Exam for All Eligible Candidates

- a. Effective 1 June 2026, the CIA Challenge Exam will be relaunched to align with the Global Internal Audit Standards™.
- b. All eligible candidates, regardless of their credential, will take the same exam.

2. Testing Windows

- a. Beginning 1 April 2026, applications will be accepted year-round rather than during designated application windows.
- b. The Challenge Exam includes four testing windows each year: February, June, September (previously August), and November 2026.
- c. The first administration (June 2026) will be a crucial data-collection window to establish a reliable passing standard. Candidates testing in June will receive their official exam results within eight weeks of their exam date
